



ABOARD M/S SUERTE



The M/S Suerte is a 227.36ft /69.3m motor yacht, custom built in 2015 by Tankoa Yachts, Genoa, Italy and designed by naval architect Studio Ruggerio. Francesco Paszkowski was responsible for her exterior. Francesco Paszkowski and Margherita Casprini designed the interior. Special interior element are the Abimis kitchens.

Suerte's interior layout sleeps up to 12 guests in 6 rooms, including a master suite, 1 VIP stateroom, 2 double cabins, 2 twin cabins and 1 convertible cabin. She is also capable of carrying up to 18 crew on board to ensure a relaxed luxury yacht experience. Timeless styling, beautiful furnishings and sumptuous seating feature throughout create an elegant and comfortable atmosphere.

Suerte is built with a steel hull and an aluminum superstructure. This custom full-displacement yacht also features 'at anchor

stabilizers' which work at zero speed, increasing on-board comfort at anchor and in rough waters. The yacht has a cruising speed of 11 knots, a maximum speed of 16.5 knots.

The shipbuilders collaborated with the best 'Made in Italy' brands. One of these was Abimis, a kitchen brand which stems from Prisma's 30-year experience in professional catering. It supplied the vessel with state-of-the-art kitchen technology. Located on the lower deck, the 'Ego' kitchen is designed to enhance and improve user experience during every stage of cooking.

Ego is made 100% from AISI 304 stainless steel, an organically-neutral material which does not transfer any substance onto food. In addition, it can withstand corrosion, temperatures of up to 500° C, can be cleaned easily and is 100% recyclable.


